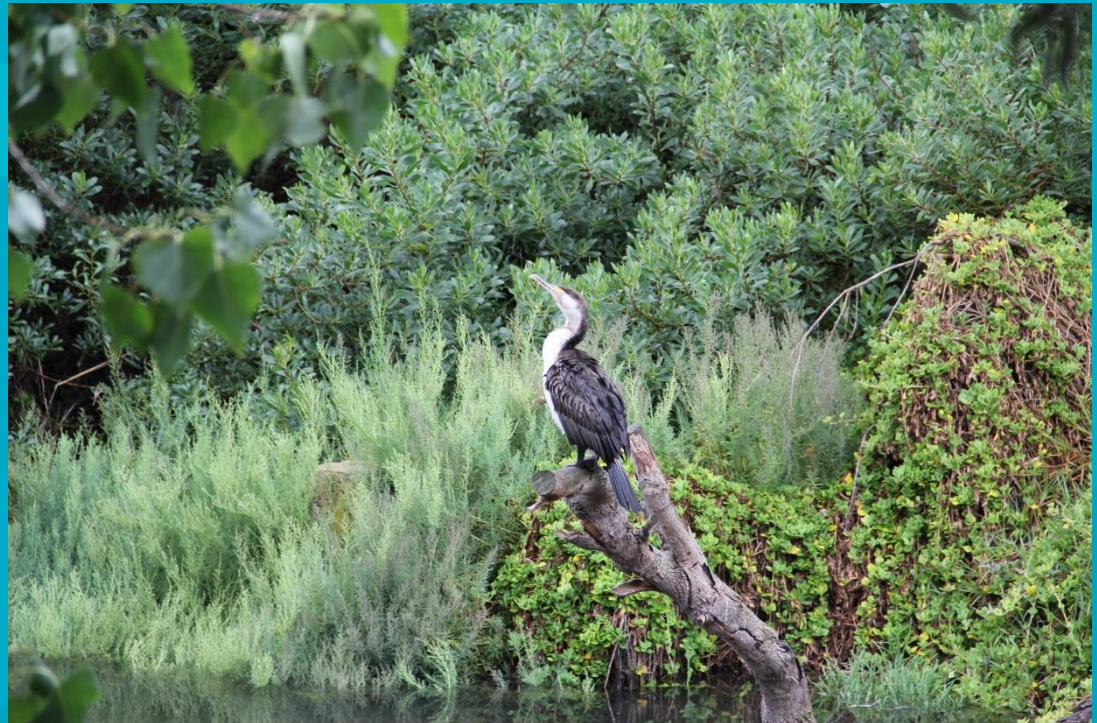

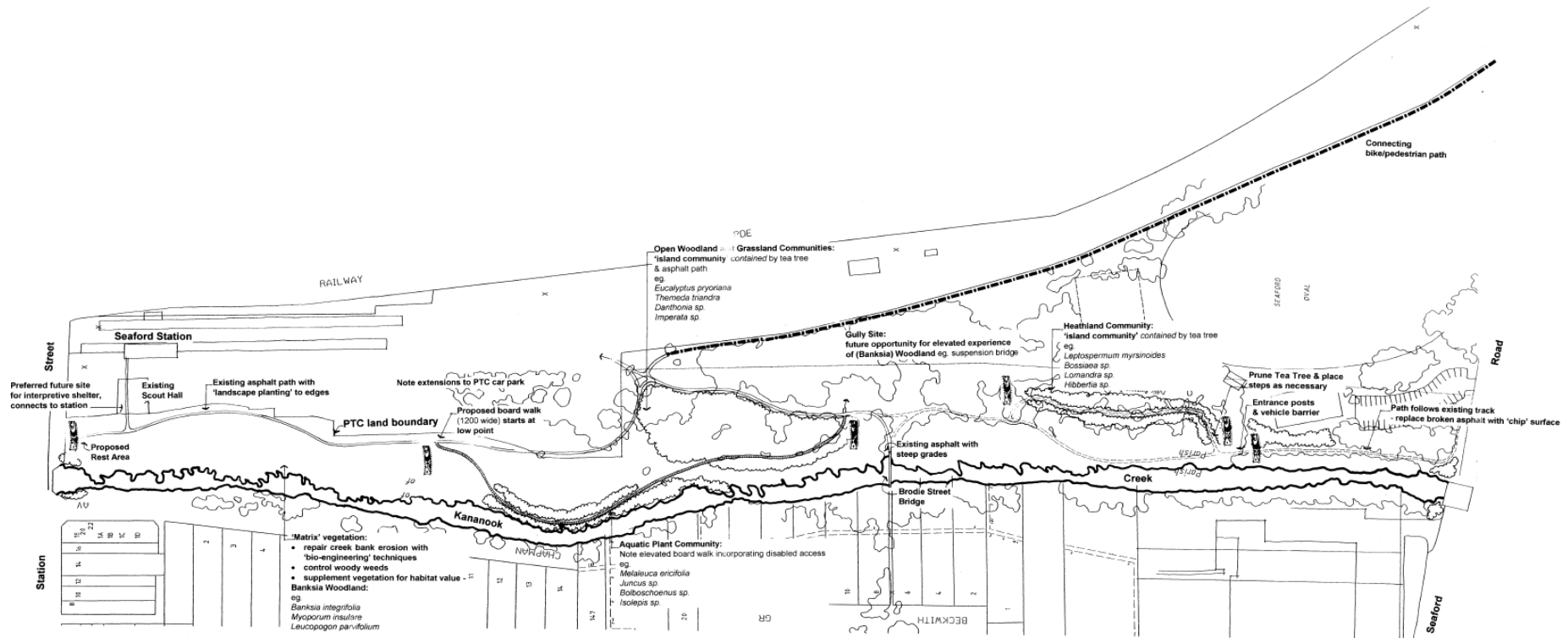


# Vision & Outcomes

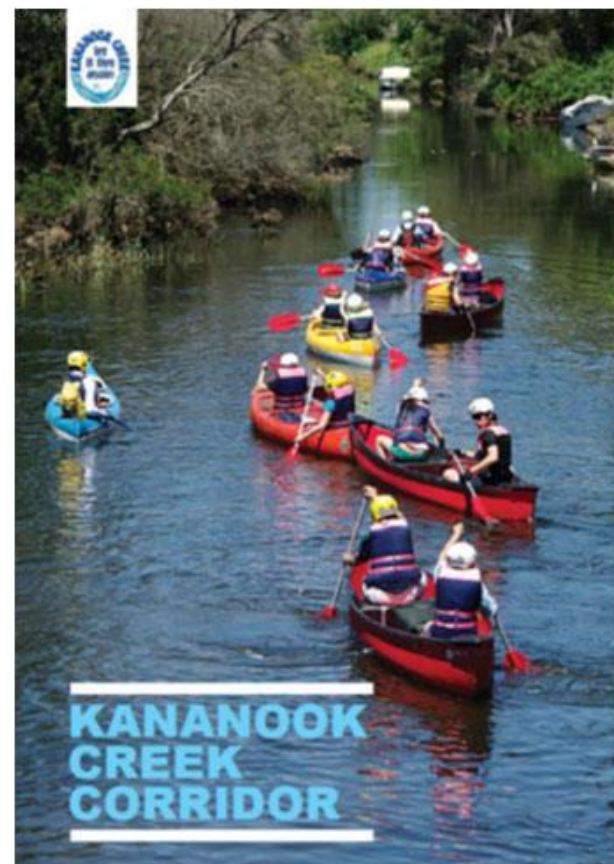

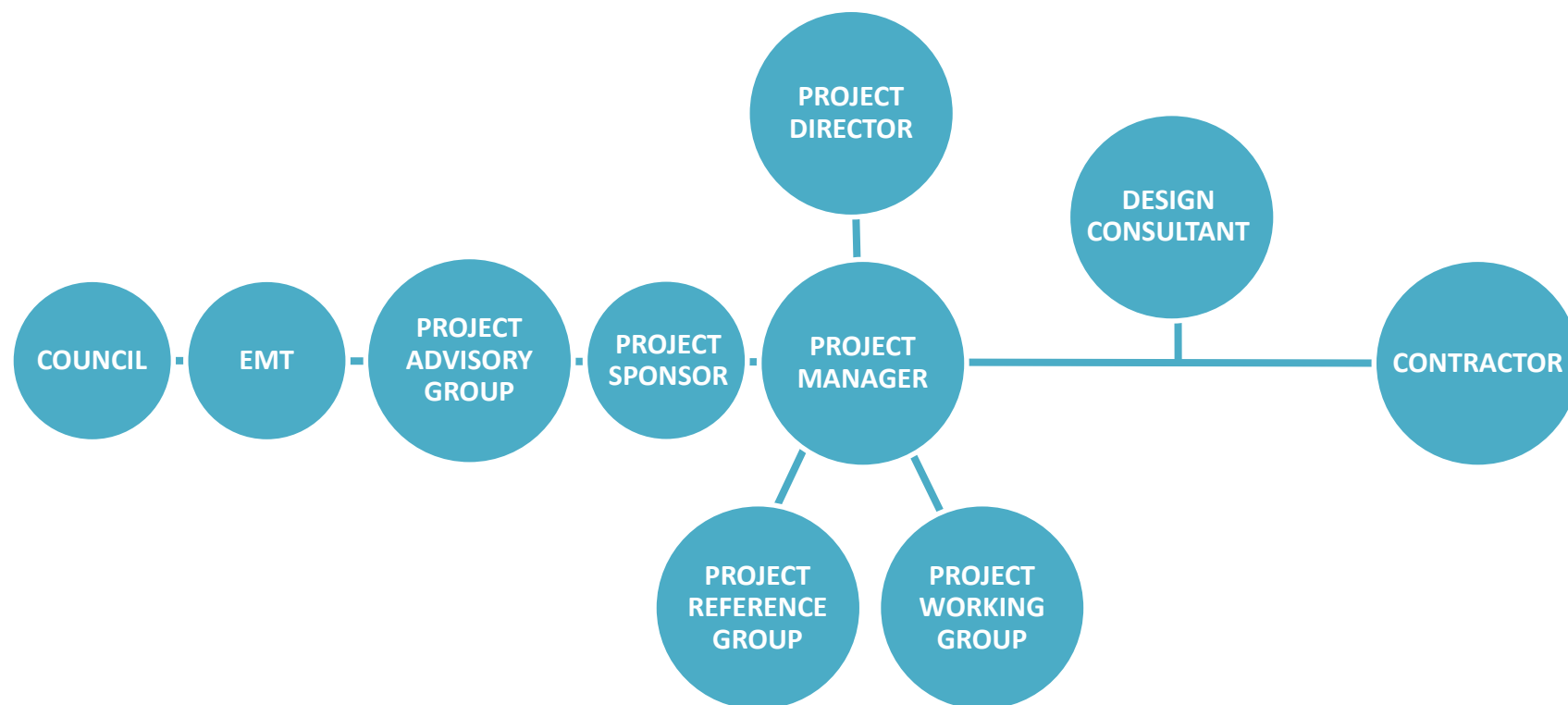

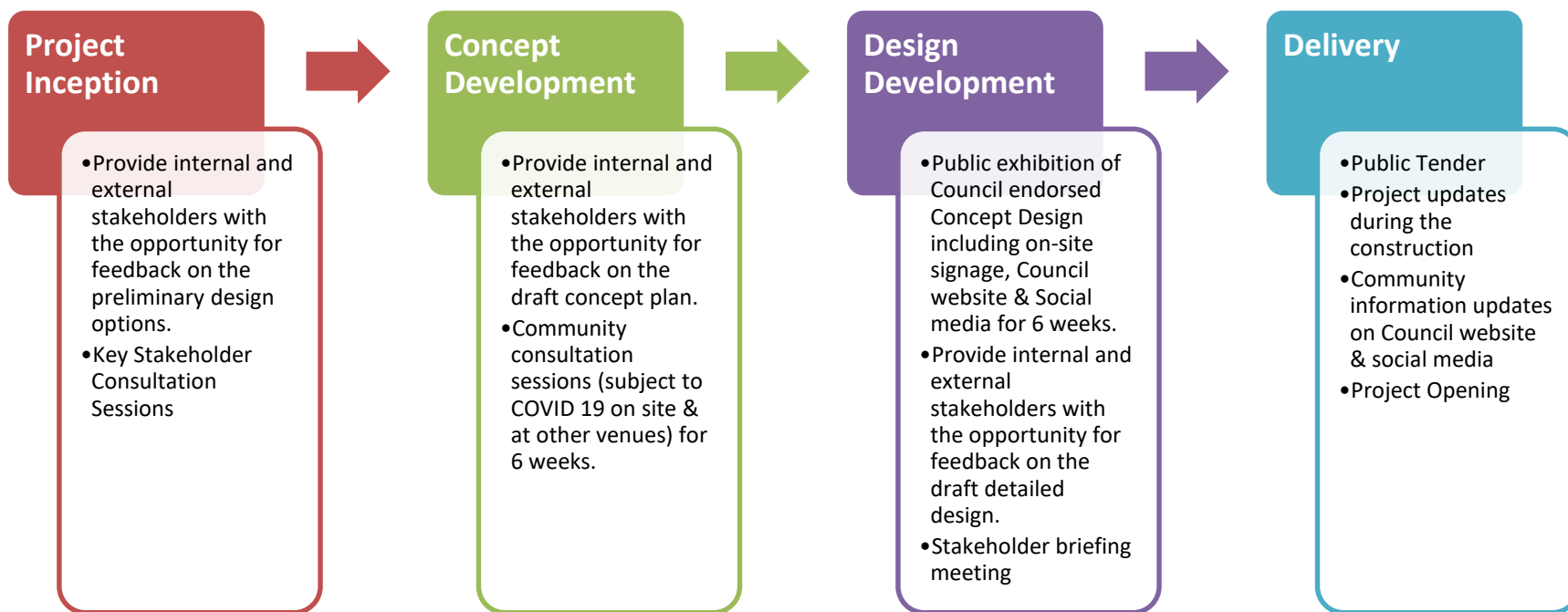
