LABOR TO CALL IN THE EXPERTS AND PROTECT KANANOOK CREEK

An Andrews Labor Government will get expert advice on Kananook Creek to protect it from inappropriate development under the Napthine Government.

Shadow Minister for Planning, Brian Tee, announced the plan alongside Labor's candidates for Carrum and Frankston, Sonya Kilkenny and Paul Edbrooke.

The expert panel will consult with the community and provide advice to protect the environmental and community value of the creek.

Labor will create a management plan and a new planning scheme for the area, and will also decide which agency is best to manage the creek to make sure it remains a local asset.
